

## Certified Organizer Coach® (COC®)

### Summary of Recertification Requirements for 2017

Typically for organizer coaches certified in 2014

#### Coach Training

- ♦ 40 hours total of Continuing Coach Education, including:
  - 24 hours *minimum* of coaching core competency ('coach-specific') training
  - 16 hours *maximum* of 'optional training or resource development' (personal development, practice building or other skills and tools applicable to coaching, ADHD, organizing or other subjects which indirectly relate to or which may be used to inform your use of coaching core competencies). Self-study hours, whether the self-study topic is coaching core competencies or resource development, may be counted as part of these 16 hours.

#### Mentor Coaching in the Core Competencies

- ♦ Ten hours of mentor coaching over a minimum of three months with an ICF-credentialed ACC, PCC or MCC coach following ICF guidelines for mentor coaching. [Seven of the ten hours may be acquired in a group mentor coaching course with no more than ten students. The major focus of all hours for this requirement must be on training or supervision of core competency coaching skills.]

#### Client Coaching Hours

- ♦ 30 hours of client coaching. There is no minimum requirement for integrated coaching hours (integrated with on-site organizing) vs. whole session coaching hours (independent of on-site organizing), but the hours must be identified as one or the other on the application.
- ♦ At least 20 of the 30 hours must be paid (maximum of 5 unpaid for each, integrated or independent)
- ♦ Minimum of 3 clients
- ♦ Up to 10 hours with a client who is/was a fellow student, but these hours must be independent from coaching coursework (in any coach training program).

#### Signed Statements

- ♦ *The Organizer Coach Code of Ethics*
- ♦ *The Statement of Agreement and Compliance*

#### Recertification Application & Fee – \$200

These requirements must have been met subsequent to the submission date of your last COC application.

Through synthesizing Organizer Coach training and identification of coaching hours in the context of an organizing process, the COC® credential defines the Organizer Coach coaching specialty. Its requirements exceed those for an International Coaching Federation (ICF) Associate Certified Coach (ACC) credential.

Requirements and fees are subject to change. Application & guidelines specific to each annual recertification cycle will list final requirements and be available in the fall for the subsequent late winter application window. Ask about exact dates.
